ADMISSION TO THE BACHELOR OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION COURSE IN THE SESSION 2023 – 2024

- B.P.Ed is a two years (Day) course as approved by NCTE.
- This is a residential course. Classes will begin at 5.50 a.m. in the morning and continue till evening with a mid-day break.

Conditions of Eligibility:

- (a) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the Inter-College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.
OR
- (b) Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.
OR
- (c) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied Physical Education as compulsory/elective subject.
OR
- (d) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/ Inter University/State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College/ Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.
OR
- (e) Bachelor's degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.
OR
- (f) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B categories shall be as per the rules of the State Government.

Candidates who have completed results of B.A/B.Sc course or equivalent can apply for admission to B.P.Ed course.

Current students of B.A/B.Sc or its equivalent courses who have appeared or due to appear in final examination of B.A/B.Sc or its equivalent are also eligible to apply. Such candidates should input the total marks obtained in **one (1) to four(4) or five(5) semester examinations of B.A/B.Sc or its equivalent course at the time of application.**

At the time of counseling/ admission those students (if provisionally selected) must submit a proof of completion of B.A/ B.Sc Final Examination, 2023 authenticated by the appropriate authority of his/her college/ institute/ university in prescribed format. They will be required to submit their final mark-sheet positively by September 29, 2023.

All admissions are provisional.

As per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD(R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and 1465-BCW/MR-67/10 dt.30/04/2010 from the Government of West Bengal, Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal unless they can produce Domicile Certificate for residing in West Bengal for at least 10 years issued by the competent authority.

The candidates who will be provisionally selected under the OBC- A and OBC- B categories must produce an OBC certificate (the date of issue of the certificate should not be earlier than March 2022) issued by the competent authority that clearly indicates (i) the category (A or B) they belong to; (ii) that they do not belong to creamy layer of the society, at the time of counselling/ admission.

OBC-A and OBC-B candidates of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal, unless they can produce a domicile certificate of 10-year residency issued by competent authority.

Candidates who do not satisfy the eligibility criteria as mentioned above will not be considered for admission, even if he/she is provisionally called for admission test and/or provisionally selected for admission.

Applicants are requested to carefully read the Instructions given in the prescribed application form. Students will be admitted against SC/ST/OBC-A & B Quota as per state Govt. rules.

For the candidates under the SC/ST/OBC-A & B Quota: Certificates must be obtained from a competent authority in the name of the candidates themselves.

All applicants have to be produced all the original mark-sheets and certificates for verification on the day of admission test.

The applicants must produce fitness certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner at the time of admission test, otherwise he/she will not be allowed for admission test. Selected candidates will be required to submit another fitness certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner at the time of reporting on the day for the B.P.Ed. Course when the physical mode of course again start.

Selection Procedure: Selection of candidates will be made on the basis

- A. Practical tests: 50 marks (5x10)
 - i. 50mtr. Run,
 - ii. Shuttle Run- 4x10mtr.,
 - iii. Standing Broad Jump,
 - iv. 600 mtr. Run,
 - v. Medicine ball overhead back throw
- B. Written Test: 30 marks
 - i. MCQ and brief answer type questions related with Physical Education and Sports
 - ii. General knowledge
- C. Academic Score: 20 marks
 - i. Higher Secondary- 10 marks
 - ii. Graduate- 10 marks

Full marks: 100

All eligible applicants will be required to appear at the Admission Test (Practical & Written) on the specified date and time and also at an interview after the Practical Test on the same day.

List of **candidates called for appearing in the Admission Test and the schedule of Admission Test** will be published on **05/4/2023** on the university website www.jaduniv.edu.in.

Admission test (Practical & written) is likely to be held **at 6.00 a.m. on 11/4/2023, 12/4/2023 & 13/4/2023** at the Jadavpur University Playground. Candidates should **enquire** about the **schedule of the Admission Test** at University website on **05/4/2023**. He/she must produce fitness certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner at the time of practical test, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear in the test. Selected candidates will be required to submit another fitness certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner at the time of reporting for the course.

No Separate Call Card will be sent to individual candidates.

No candidate will be considered for admission **unless he/she appears at the written test after the Admission Test (Practical)**. Candidates are to directly report to the Head of the Department concerned 30 minutes before the scheduled time on the date of the Admission Test.

No candidate who does not satisfy the eligibility criteria will be considered for admission, even if he/she appears at the Admission Test and Interview and also if he/she has been provisionally selected for admission.

The merit list as well as admission instructions for the provisionally selected candidates will be published on **25/4/2023 after 4.00 p.m.**

No separate intimation will be sent to individual candidates. Subsequent lists of provisionally selected candidates against vacancies, if any, will also be put up on the University website.

Students are required to reside in the University Hostel. The fees for Educational Tour/ Blazer and other sports clothing/camp/mess charge etc will be notified at the time of admission. The fees are non-refundable. If a student cancels his/her admission, he/she may apply for refund of the fees. The fees will be refunded [as per the order no- 209 (29-Edn(U)/1U-32/17 dated 24/7/2017) of State Govt.] only if any candidate on the waiting list is admitted against the vacancy created. However, under no circumstances, the fees will be refunded before the completion of the academic session 2023- 2024.

All applicants must submit the print out of online application form along with the print out of money receipt and self-attested copies of mark-sheets and certificates in person or by post to the Office of the Dean and the Secretary, Faculty Council of Arts, U.G. Arts Building, Ground Floor, Jadavpur University, Kolkata 700032, on or before March 31, 2023, otherwise their candidature will be cancelled. University will not be liable for any kind of postal delay.

Jadavpur University has accepted in principle that each and every student of the University shall be duty bound during the entire period of studentship with the University to immediately report to the Dean of Students if any ragging is noticed either in University hostel or on University campus.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the Authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the Authority would expel him/her from the University.
