## ADMISSION TO THE BACHELOR OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION COURSE IN THE SESSION 2021 – 2022

- B.P.Ed is a two years (Day) course as approved by NCTE.
- This is a residential course. Classes will begin at 5.50 a.m. in the morning and continue till evening with a mid-day break (if physical mode course will start in future). For the Pandemic situation due to Covid-19 on-line mode classes will be continued six days/week and thus the schedule will be given in due course of time.

### Conditions of Eligibility:

- (a) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the Inter-College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.  
OR
- (b) Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.  
OR
- (c) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied Physical Education as compulsory/elective subject.  
OR
- (d) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/ Inter University/State competitions or secured 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> position in Inter College/ Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.  
OR
- (e) Bachelor's degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.  
OR
- (f) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B categories shall be as per the rules of the State Government.

### **All admissions are provisional.**

**As per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD(R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and letter No.1510-SCW dt.31/05/2007 from the Government of West Bengal, Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal unless they can produce Domicile Certificate for residing in West Bengal for at least 10 years issued by the competent authority.**

**The candidates who will be provisionally selected under the OBC- A and OBC- B categories must produce an OBC certificate (the date of issue of the certificate should not be earlier than September 2020) issued by the competent authority that clearly indicates (i) the category (A or B) they belong to; (ii) that they do not belong to creamy layer of the society, at the time of counselling/ admission.**

**OBC-A and OBC-B candidates of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal, unless they can produce a domicile certificate of 10-year residency issued by competent authority.**

Candidates who do not satisfy the eligibility criteria will not be considered for admission, even if he/she is provisionally selected for admission by mistake.

Applicants are requested to carefully read the Instructions given in the prescribed application form. Students will be admitted against SC/ST/OBC-A & B Quota as per state Govt. rules.

For the candidates under the SC/ST/OBC-A & B Quota: Certificates must be obtained from a competent authority in the name of the candidates themselves.

If the candidate is selected, the original certificates will have to be produced for verification at the time of interview and admission.

The applicants must produce fitness certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner at the time of Admission, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to admit for the course. Selected candidates will be required to submit another fitness certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner at the time of reporting on the day for the B.P.Ed. Course when the physical mode of course again start.

**No Separate Call Card will be sent to individual candidates.**

Students are required to reside in the University Hostel (when physical mode course will start in future). The fees for Educational Tour/ Blazer and other sports clothing/camp/mess charge etc will be notified later on (when physical mode course will start in future). The fees are non-refundable. If a student cancels his/her admission, he/she may apply for refund of the fees. The fees will be refunded as per the rules of the University.

Jadavpur University has accepted in principle that each and every student of the University shall be duty bound during the entire period of studentship with the University to immediately report to the Dean of Students if any ragging is noticed either in University hostel or on University campus.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the Authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the Authority would expel him/her from the University.

## Selection Procedure For B.P.Ed. Course

Out of 50 seats 38 seats are earmarked for male students and 12 seats for female students. There will be separate merit lists for male candidates and female candidates.
